

The course reopened in September 2015 to rave reviews, leaving them confident of possibly taking the No.1 spot from none other than Augusta National itself.

Hilton Head National Golf Club, located in Bluffton, SC is just one mile from the bridges to Hilton Head Island and a half hour's drive from historic downtown Savannah, GA. It sits adjacent to the new luxury Hilton Head National RV Resort.

The course itself is a golfing gem. It has been acclaimed for more than 30 years as "the best conditioned layout in the region." Moreover, it's routinely rated among the top public courses in South Carolina.

Hall of Fame golfer Gary Player and course architecture award winner Bobby Weed each contributed their distinctive design philosophies here in ways that make every club in your bag important. 




Free Day Options

Ryan, Chris & Joe have direct access to one of the most prestigious and unusual golfing venues. Haig Point Golf Club is the World's only 20-hole golf course, where 2 Par 3 holes have an A & B tee option, due to their degree of difficulty.

In addition to this being extremely unusual, the course is also housed on its own private island, with the only access being via private ferry. From the minute you check in at the embarkment point, you know you are in for something special.
